From the 1950's, the company evolved to in particular, develop its specific in house design function for markets such as light fittings, food and garment display.

In the mid to late 70's the emphasis began to move towards smaller, 'kit' type products and components such as Barrier rails and bar fittings. The 1980's saw the company's design function becoming more responsive to customers' growing demand for bespoke products, whilst the 1990's saw a period of extreme evolution in which the company strived to broaden its appeal to influencers and offer yet greater bespoke design and production facility. And today, the Group has assumed almost an entirely new dynamic which fundamentally builds on the reputation and capabilities of our founding company T Saveker, but which positions us ever closer to achieving the ultimate in providing products and solutions for our customers.
